



2020 Jr. Anglers Day Modification Form

Check-in

The preregistered angler and their guardian will check-in with City Staff at the entrance of the Pier 15-20 minutes prior to their designated fishing time. Day of registration and time swaps will not be allowed. A city staff member will check the ID of the adult and wristband the angler depending on the fishing session.

Pier Entrance

- **All preregistered anglers and family members (up to 3 in addition to the angler) and staff will be temperature screened before entering the pier.** Any person with a fever of 100.1° F or greater will not be permitted to enter. Parents/guardians are encouraged to self-screen at home for any COVID-19 symptoms, including fever, and keep the child(ren) at home if any symptoms are present.
- All anglers must submit the pre-screening questionnaire prior to Friday, September 11th at 3:00 PM or their spot will be forfeited.
- Social distancing of at least 6 feet will be enforced during the check-in, fishing, and egress process.
- Anglers, family members, and staff will be instructed to wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol upon entry to the Pier and immediately after the fishing session.
- Anglers will be assigned a number at check-in that will correspond to a section on the Pier that they will be restricted to during the session.

Fishing Sessions

- Guardian must present a picture ID and be listed at a designated fishing session.
- Social distancing of at least 6 feet will be enforced.
- Anglers/family members must remain in their designated fishing spots.
- Masks or buffs must be worn during the fishing session.
- Anglers/family members will be instructed to wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol upon exiting the fishing session. We will have two portable hand washing stations on the Pier and enough hand sanitizer for each participant.
- City staff will escort the anglers/family members off the Pier at the conclusion of their session.
- Fishing sessions will be made up of 10 anglers that can bring up to 3 family members with them on the Pier. Groups will be mixed ages to keep family units together. No requests will be taken to switch groups.

Face Masks

Staff, volunteers, anglers, family members, and anyone else that enters the fishing pier will be required to properly wear masks at all times. Anglers/family members who do not follow guidelines will be removed from the event.

Food/Drink

City staff will have coolers full of water for any participants on the Pier and Anglers will receive a complimentary ice cream after their fishing session.

Covid-19 Procedures

To ensure the safety of the event participants, staff, and everyone involved with the event, these procedures listed are necessary.

If an event participant is showing symptoms of the Covid-19 virus before the event, they must provide a doctor's note and be free of fever and symptoms for a minimum of 72 hours before the event in order to participate in the event. No refund will be given if the participant doesn't notify City staff prior to their registered fishing session.

If an event participant shows symptoms of the Covid-19 Virus while at event, they will be asked to leave the Pier with their Guardian.

Some symptoms include:

- Abdominal and neck pain
- Vomiting and diarrhea
- Rash
- Feeling tired
- Bloodshot eyes
- Fever of 100.1° F or greater
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Headache
- Muscle aches
- Nausea
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
